The Erasmus KA2+ Q4EDU project aims to support VET institutions, which were badly impacted by the Covid-19 pandemic, in their digitalization process. It will focus on online tools, evaluation and examination methods, and a framework to assess digital readiness at VET level.

#### What we have done so far

Partners have started the project's activities by detailed research and analysis of the already established Quality Assurance Models, which were then compared in order to find the most adequate ones for this project. The consortium has decided on the three most adequate models which are:

- The DigCompOrg framework
- TQM tools
- EFQM model

## What we are doing now

Partners are now working on defining the profile of the Q4EDU expert and deciding the modules that will be offered to the VET teachers that would like to follow the training course. During this training course, the teachers will be able to familiarize themselves with quality assessments. indicators, and criteria, and will have the opportunity to evaluate the digital readiness of their VET institution.

The modules that will be provided are the following:

- Leadership & Governance Practices
- Teaching and Learning Practices
- **Professional Development**
- Assessment practices
- Content and Curricula
- Collaboration and Networking
- Infrastructure



#### What we will do in the future

Partners are now discussing the assessment procedure and the possibility of providing certificates to interested VET trainers after the completion of the training course. They will then develop the content of the training course, after a detailed and shared methodology developed by everyone.

## Second Transnational Project Meeting (TPM2)

The second Transnational Project Meeting took place in Thessaloniki, Greece on the 7th and 8th of April 2022 and it was hosted by Atlantis. The meeting was hybrid since some partners traveled to Thessaloniki whereas some others participated online.
