The Erasmus KA2+ Q4EDU project aims to **support VET institutions**, which were badly impacted by the Covid-19 pandemic, **in their digitalization process**. It will **focus on online tools, evaluation and examination methods, and a framework to assess digital readiness at VET level**.

What we have done so far

The Q4EDU partners have developed and disseminated the **abstracts of IO1/ A1: Selection of Methodologies** and **IO1/A2: Digital Readiness Evaluation Methodological Framework**, **IO2/A2: Training Methodology** and the **Handbook** in English, Polish, Italian and Greek as well.

Moreover, under the coordination of the University of Lodz, the partners have developed the training modules and content for the Q4EDU training course. The participants of the online course will be able to follow a training path on the seven modules below:

- Leadership and Governance Practices
- Teaching and Learning Practices
- Professional Development
- Assessment Practices



- Content and Curricula
- Collaboration and Networking
- Infrastructure

A certificate will be awarded to the learners who will successfully complete each module. Those who will complete all seven modules successfully, will also receive a certificate for the overall course completion.

What we are doing now

Digital Readiness Assessment Tool (DigiRASt) is one of the main project results of Q4EDU Project. It will be developed to provide quick assessments on digital readiness at course or secondarily organisational level based on user input. The tool will be accessible from web interface and different mobile devices like tablets, laptops, mobile phones, etc. The tool will be developed in three stages:

A1: Development of the tool (M18-M24)

A2: Internal Testing (M19-M22)

A3: Assessment Cycles and Validation (M20-M24)

The DigiRASt tool will include all following sections:

- A registration page for VET organisations,
- A creation of a dashboard with visual displays of all data taken from the registered institutions with all proposed characteristics included,
- A radar chart for comparison of the digital level of institutions with results taken from the digital readiness evaluation Methodological framework developed by the project's partners.

What we will do in the future

The development of the DigiRASt tool is the main goal of the partnership. The assessment of the tool is going to take place by involving individuals from both project partners and target groups, such as VET trainers, VET providers and so on. Practical guidelines for trainers on the implementation of the Q4EDU tool will also be made available to VET centres.

Third Transnational Project Meeting (TPM3)



The third Transnational Project Meeting took place in **Milan, Italy** on **4th October 2022**. The meeting was hosted by DLEARN with the participation of all Q4EDU partners. The event was hybrid



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with some partners having the option to participate online, due to the COVID-19 situation. During the TPM3, the partners had the chance to discuss the development of the contents of the modules and deliver a short presentation for each module. A presentation of the first version of the DigiRAsT Tool also took place.

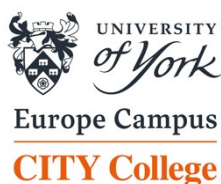
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
